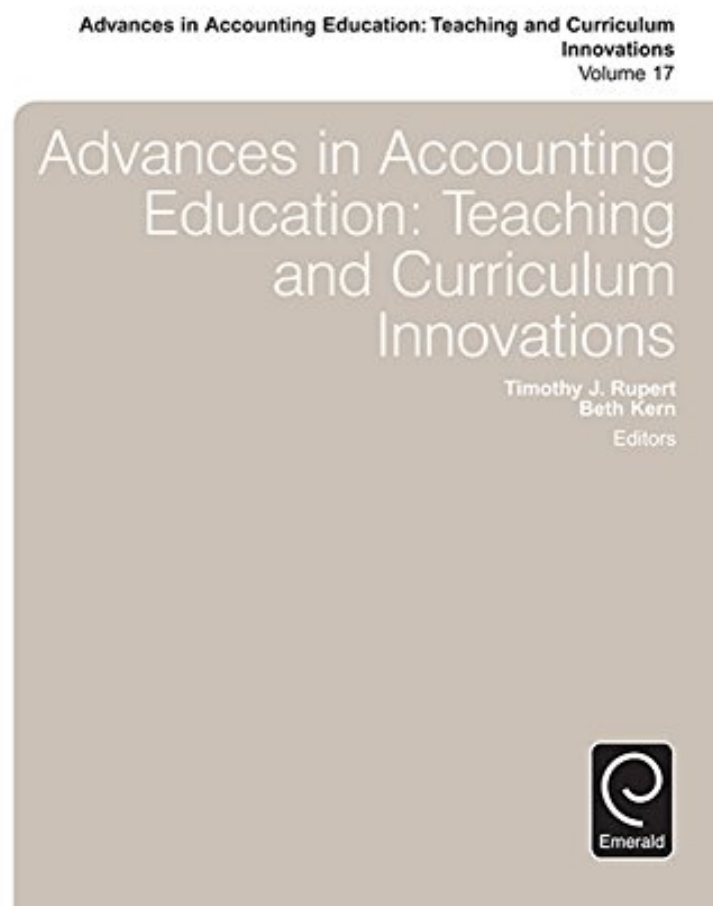

The contributions that make up the main body of the text are devoted to a fraud exercise for introductory and survey courses in accounting, the use of alternative quiz formats to enhance students experiences in the introductory accounting course, and a wide variety of other related subjects.
